- 1. Promoters: Wolverhampton & South Staffs. Car Club.
- 2. Title: "Express and Star" Rally.
- 3. Date: February 25th and 26th, 1961.
- 4. A National British Event.
- 5. The Rally is governed by the Standing Supplementary Regulations (1960) of the R.A.C. and these additional Supplementary Regulations.
- 6. R.A.C. Permit No. E 405.
- 7. The Rally is open to all drivers holding an International Competition Licence (1961) (issued by the R.A.C. Competition Department, Pall Mall, London, S.W.1), and valid for the event. This must be produced at the start.
- 8. Start at the following places between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m. on Saturday, 25th February, at exact times and places to be notified:—
 - 1. Wolverhampton.
 - 2. Liverpool.
 - 3. Hereford.
 - 4. Oxford.
 - 5. Nottingham.

Competitors may select whichever starting Control they prefer. Competitors to report not later than 30 minutes before their due starting time.

- 9. Total distance approximately 325 miles finishing at Wolverhampton early on Sunday morning 26th February.
- 10. Classes: There will be only one class throughout except insofar as is required to determine the distribution of the six First Class awards mentioned in Para. 11.

11. Awards:

Outright Winner: The "Express and Star" Trophy (to be held for one year) with replica and £25 cash.

Navigator: The "Raybould Smith" Trophy (to be held for one year) with replica and £15 cash.

Second Driver: Pint Tankard and £15 cash.

Navigator: Half-pint Tankard and £10 cash.

Third Driver: Pint Tankard and £10 cash.

Navigator: Half-pint Tankard and £5 cash.

 Selection is to be at the organisers' discretion.
- 13. Entries close on Tuesday, 31st January, 1961. Late entries (up to first post 7th February, 1961) can only be accepted at the organisers' discretion and upon payment of a late entry fee of £1 0s. 0d.

Entries open on 12th December, 1960.

- 14. The Entry Fee is £4 4s. 0d. per car, and £1 0s. 0d. for a team entry of two cars. A car may be entered in more than one team.
- 15. Entries are to be sent to the Assistant Secretary of the Meeting. They will be acknowledged immediately but formal acceptance will be indicated by the despatch of competition numbers, driving test details, breakfast tickets, and any final instructions that may be necessary. If any entrant has not received these by 20th February he should notify the Assistant Secretary at once.

18. Results will be announced and awards presented at Wolverhampton as soon as possible after the finish.

Protests must be made, IN WRITING, and accompanied by a fee of £5 5s. 0d. within 30 minutes of the announcement of results.

19. Competitors' numbers will be posted to them and are to be mounted at front and rear of the vehicle for the time during which that vehicle is competing. Numbers must be removed at the finish or on retirement. Start: Competitors will be started in order at the organisers discretion at intervals of one minute.

Route card(s) and/or marked map(s) will be issued to each competitor on departure from certain controls.

20. Driving Tests:

There will be a driving test en route.

The result of the test will be used only to determine placings of those competitors with the same total road penalty.

21. Controls:

All controls on the Night Navigation Section will be Time Controls. Competitors will not be booked in at any of the Time Controls until they hand their Road Book and Sealed Watch to the Marshal. Througout the whole event, the onus will be on the competitor to see that his/her road book is correctly stamped or marked.

Lateness at Controls: R.A.C. S.S.R. 1960 Para. D. 32 shall apply.

- 22. Timing: Certain sections will be timed by sealed watches for which a deposit of £1 10s. 0d. must be paid on receipt of watch (refund may be obtained at the final road control). The collecting point for watches will be stated on the route card. In the event of failure of a competitor's sealed watch, that competitor will be timed by Marshals' watches which will be synchronised with B.B.C. time. (A watch is deemed to have failed if it loses or gains 5 or more minutes). On sections not timed by sealed watches B.B.C. time will be observed.
- 23. Penalties will be as R.A.C. S.S.R 1960 Para. D. 34 with the following

Para. D. 34 (c) — For 150 substitute 300.

Para. D. 34 (p) — Add "Noise checks will operate".

Para. D. 34 (r) — Delete paragraph complete.

Para. D. 34 (m) - Delete "over one minute".

Passing through a control (other than X Control)

more than once, or turning round in a control ... 300 marks
On each occasion of observed failure to close a gate 150 marks

Substitution of, or intereference with Sealed Watch-

Disqualification.

24. Additional Details:

Breakfast and washing facilities will be available at the finish at Wolverhampton. The number of breakfasts required must be ordered and paid for when submitting the Entry Form. There will be one compulsory halt of 60 minutes duration, the position of which will be shown on the Route Card. Meals, hot drinks, sandwiches, etc., and petrol will be available. Competitors should take on sufficient petrol for at least 220 miles.

25. Final Instructions, etc.:

Any further instructions, including the Final Instructions, issued to Competitors shall have the same force as these Supplementary Regulations.

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
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
